Grade Level: Kindergarten – 2nd Grade

Subject: Phonics

Unit: The Reading Process

Frameworks:

RF.1.2.A Distinguish long from short vowels in spoken one-syllable words.

RF.1.2.B Orally produce one-syllable words by blending sounds (phonemes) including consonant blends

Objective:

Students will be able to recognize the symbol for each vowel and recognize the long and short sound in a word.

Goal: Students will utilize technology to practice the sound to symbol relation between the vowels and the sounds they represent.

Activity:

The teacher will guide the class to use the following link http://www.softschools.com/language_arts/phonics/phonics_games.jsp this can either be done whole group with a smart board, small group with iPads or individually with personal devices.

Materials:

Computer with internet access (smart board or personal computer or iPad).

Links to sites utilized.

Work sheets and pencil.

Procedures: Student or teacher will click on the game Short vowel sound words and then the Generate tab. Play the game. Click the down arrow on the drop box and move to the game Short a sound words and then the Generate tab. Play the game. Click the down arrow on the drop box and move to the game Short e sound words and then the Generate tab. Play the game. Click the down arrow on the drop box and move to the game Short i sound words and then the Generate tab. Play the game. Click the down arrow on the drop box and move to the game Short o sound words and then the Generate tab. Play the game. Click the down arrow on the drop box and move to the game Short u sound words and then the Generate tab. Click the down arrow on the drop box and move to the game Long vowel

sound and complex words. Play the game.
